- Food Servers (10) Serve the homeless and poor by filling trays with food from a cafeteria-like line.
- Serving Assistants (2) Carry trays to tables, assist with beverages, distribute baked products, etc.
- Greeter Guys (2) Welcome and greet guests as they arrive for their meal.
- Huggers (2) Based at the front line to talk with guests as they wait for their meal.
- Gift Givers (4) Hand out small gifts at the door as the guests enter.
- Books Love Kids (2) Listen and read to children and hand out books.
- GFC Gift Bags (5) Put together Gift Bags and write Cards of Encouragement which will be distributed to women in transitional housing.
- Photographers (2) Take candid shots of volunteers assisting guests in various projects, avoiding face shots Of the guests to protect their privacy
- Placemats and Lunch Bag Decorating (10) A great job for kids and young teen along with a parent.
- Create Christmas Stockings (10) Fill 200 Christmas Stockings with pre-sorted gifts. Great job for teens and children 8 years plus accompanied by adult. (Adult and child counts as 1)
